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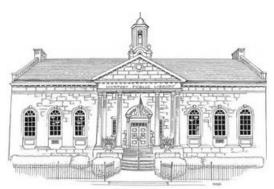

ABOUT THE VOTE:

The Small Cities School District law allows you to vote on any increase in the annual appropriation from tax levy for the Lockport Public Library. The vote is held every year. This is not a new tax. The library has always received most of its funding from taxes.

THE LIBRARY BUDGET PROPOSITION:

The Lockport Public Library is a school district library, which means that it is chartered to serve the same geographic location as the school district. It receives most of its funding from taxes raised by the tax levy. The Library Board of Trustees has proposed an increase of \$39,682 in the tax levy to support the library's operating budget for fiscal year 2024/2025. This is the amount allowable under the Tax Cap. You are voting "yes" or "no" on the proposed increase.
